


## Ruby On Rails

- Convention Over Configuration
- Don't Repeat Yourself
- MVC

#### MVC

- Models represent data.
- Views represent user interface.
- Controllers connect models and views.



## **Don't Repeat Yourself**

Single, authoritative, unambiguous

## **Convention Over Configuration**

Only specify unconventional aspects of app

#### **Active Record Pattern**

- Table is wrapped into a class.
- Instance of an object is a row.
- Logic and Data are a unified package.

# How does it work?

## **Components of Rails**

- Action Pack
- Action Mailer
- Active Model
- Active Record
- Active Resource
- Active Support

#### **Action Controller**

- Processes requests
- Extracts Parameters
- Dispatches to intended action

#### **Action View**

Handles routing

## **Action Mailer**


Handles e-mail

#### **Active Model**

Provides interface between action pack and Object Relationship Mapping gems such as Active Record

#### **Active Record**

- Base for models
- Allows for database independence
- Basic CRUD functionality
- Advanced Finding Capabilities
- Relational
